Old Business

Annexation Agreement with the School Dist (hearing @ 6:30 August 3rd)- The Village Ordinances at Section 38-1-4(B) (2) do authorize the district to provide utility services to noncontiguous properties outside of its corporate limits so long as the owner of the property enters into an annexation agreement which states that the property will be annexed into the Village if, at any time in the future, the property does become contiguous to the Village.

Motion was made by Trustee Vineyard to proceed so the Ordinance can be reviewed and passed, and seconded by Trustee Allen. 3 Yeas carried the motion.

Movie Night- Movie Night has been moved to September 18th from September 11th.

New Business

Create Line on Accounts for Vehicle Replacement- Motion was made by Trustee Edward to create the line item and seconded by Trustee Allen. 3 Yeas carried the motion.
